C. Other information

Language Requirements:

For courses at CHS:

Students wishing to take College courses taught in Japanese are expected to have the equivalent of the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N2 or above.

Accommodation and Cost of Living*:

CHS will reserve accommodation for exchange students. All rooms are single rooms with desk and bed in separate men's and women's dormitories. The monthly cost is around ¥75,000, including breakfast, dinner, electricity, and Internet.

Each dormitory is located 30 minutes away from CHS. Exchange students may purchase a commuter pass to the college. The pass costs about ¥3,000 / month.

Estimated monthly living costs in Tokyo are around ¥100,000.

*Please note that arrangements regarding payment of accommodation expenses may be different according to the details of each university's exchange agreement. Students should confirm these arrangements with their home universities.

International Student Support:

Over 170 international students are studying at CHS during the 2020-2021 academic year. Academic and daily support for international students is provided by:

(1) The Academic Affairs Section, which arranges orientation sessions for exchange students to assist them in adjusting to campus life at CHS. The office also helps with registration procedures, visas, course selection, and academic transcripts.

(2) The Student Affairs Section, which arranges parties and short trips to promote exchanges between international students and CHS students.

(3) The CHS web-portal system, which international students can use to obtain information and to check class assignments.
